

Election Day Poll Worker Jobs

Thank you for expressing an interest in becoming an Election Day Poll Workers. Poll Workers will help set up and open the polling place, greet voters, assist voters and close the polling place.

Qualifications

- Citizen of the United States
- Resident and Registered Voter of Carroll County
- Or a resident of a neighboring county (must have a wavier from neighboring election office)
- At least 16 years of age
- No prior felony convictions for at least 10 years
- Attend Mandatory Training
- Reliable transportation to and from training and election day
- Not a candidate for office or an immediate relative of a candidate for office in the assigned poll
- Not hold a public office
- Ability to perform duties and functions of a poll worker
 - All poll workers must be at their assigned polling place at **6:00 am**
 - The day ends when all election evidence is complete, approximately **8:00 pm**
 - Once you are sworn in at the polling place, you are required to stay
 - Will greet voters, determine eligibility and assist as needed
 - Some computer knowledge is helpful
 - Standing, sitting and light lifting
 - You will need to provide your own drinks, food, medication (if needed), etc.
 - Breaks and lunch will be staggered
 - Poll workers should either early vote or vote absentee by mail
- Carroll County payroll issues check by mail on a bi-weekly schedule.
