A RESOLUTION AND ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE APPROPRIATIONS AND EXPENDITURES OF FUNDS FOR THE GOVERNMENT OF CARROLL COUNTY, GEORGIA, FOR THE COUNTY FISCAL YEAR 2024, BEGINNING JULY 1, 2023 AND ENDING JUNE 30, 2024; PROVIDING FOR THE OPERATIONS OF COUNTY DEPARTMENTS, BOARDS, AGENCIES, ELECTED OFFICES, AND OTHER GOVERNMENTAL ACTIVITIES; TO PROVIDE FOR THE LEVEL OF PERSONNEL AUTHORIZED FOR THE VARIOUS DEPARTMENTS AND AGENCIES; TO PROVIDE FOR CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS AS BUDGETED FOR THE COUNTY; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

WHEREAS, in compliance with O.C.G.A. 36-8-1 and the County's enabling legislation, a revenue estimate for the following year and proposed budget that will govern expenditures of all funds expected to be available to the County for the following year, including expenditures relating to capital outlays and public works projects, has been submitted to the Board of Commissioners; and

WHEREAS, a copy of the proposed budget along with all required public notices has been published; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Authority held a public hearing on June 6, 2023, at 10:00 A.M.; and

WHEREAS, the proposed budget and recommendations have been presented to the Board of Commissioners including recommendations for changes in positions as follows:

- Addition of one full-time IT Specialist position for the IT Department;
- Addition of one part-time Court Coordinator for State Court;
- Addition of one full-time Victim Advocate position for Solicitor's Office;
- Addition of one full-time Gymnastics Coordinator positions for Recreation;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of Carroll County, Georgia, as follows:

Section 1. Pursuant to O.C.G.A. § 36-81-1, et seq, as amended, the sums of money summarized in Exhibit A attached hereto and made a part of this Resolution and Ordinance, shall be and are hereby adopted by the Board of Commissioners as the Operating Budget and Capital Budget for the government of Carroll County, Georgia for Fiscal Year 2024 beginning on July 1, 2023 and ending on June 30, 2024. Furthermore, the Board of Commissioners hereby adopts the Chairman's proposed changes in certain positions, departments, and offices as follows:

- Addition of one full-time IT Specialist position for the IT Department;
- Addition of one part-time Court Coordinator for State Court;
- Addition of one full-time Victim Advocate position for Solicitor's Office;
- Addition of one full-time Gymnastics Coordinator positions for Recreation;

<u>Section 2.</u> The appropriations of all funds for all departments and agencies shall be as set forth in Exhibit A.

Section 3. The fee schedules attached hereto as Exhibit B shall be the fees for each respective department and shall be published on the County's website.

<u>Section 4.</u> The funds provided and contracts made herein for the procurement of supplies, materials, and services for all departments and agencies shall be expended in accordance with the budget, its attachments, and purchasing policies and procedures established by the County.

Section 5. The financial transactions of all County departments and agencies authorized to expend County funds shall be recorded and maintained in accordance with generally accepted accounting principles and standards.

<u>Section 6.</u> In accordance with Georgia Code § 33-8-8, the proceeds from the tax on insurance premiums, estimated to be \$5,600,000, shall be used for the provision of fire protection services for residents of the unincorporated area of the County.

<u>Section 7.</u> The budget documents and attachments entitled Fiscal Year 2024 Adopted Budget for Carroll County, Georgia shall be maintained on file in the Office of the Board of Commissioners and available for public inspection.

<u>Section 8.</u> A copy of the final budget adopted shall be transmitted to the Grand Jury of the Superior Court of Carroll County.

Section 9. The Budget and other matters set forth in this Resolution and Ordinance shall be effective as of July 1, 2023.

<u>Section 10.</u> All Ordinances, Resolutions or other acts, or parts thereof, in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed.
