<p style="text-align: center;">Continuation of 1% Sales and Use Tax (Vote for One)</p> <p>Shall a special one percent sales and use tax be continued in Carroll County for a period of time of six years for the raising of approximately \$205,378,104 for the purpose of funding capital outlay projects, including facilities and equipment: (a) for Carroll County, Georgia: (i) Sheriff's Office Replacement and Jail Modernization Project, including Mental Health Addition, (ii) Public Safety and Fire Department, (iii) Roads, Streets, Bridges, Sidewalks, and Transportation, Public Works, (iv) Recreation and Parks, (v) Administrative and IT, (vi) Judicial, (vii) Community Impact and Economic Development, and (viii) Agricultural Projects and Farmland and Watershed Protection; (b) for the City of Bowdon, Georgia: (i) Roads, Streets, Bridges, and Sidewalks, (ii) Police, (iii) Recreation and Parks, (iv) Water/Sewer Infrastructure Improvements, (v) City Hall, (vi) Parking, and (vii) Downtown Development/Downtown Historic Preservation; (c) for the City of Bremen, Georgia: (i) Public Safety Vehicles and Equipment; (d) for the City of Carrollton, Georgia: (i) Parks and Recreation, (ii) Engineering, (iii) Administrative, (iv) Information Technology, (v) Police, (vi) Fire; and (vii) Sanitation; (e) for the City of Mount Zion, Georgia: (i) Roads, Streets, Bridges, and Sidewalks, (ii) Water, (iii) Parks and Recreation, (iv) Police, (v) Administrative and (vi) Economic Development; (f) for the Town of Roopville, Georgia: (i) City Administration, (ii) Water, and (iii) Recreation; (g) for the benefit of the City of Temple, Georgia: (i) Community Development/Economic Development, (ii) Public Works, Road, Sidewalks and Water, (iii) Public Safety, (iv) Recreation, (v) Senior Center, (vi) Sewer Treatment Plant, and (vii) Heavy Equipment and Vehicles; (h) for the City of Villa Rica, Georgia: (i) Transportation and Public Works, (ii) Culture, Recreation, Parks, and Senior Center Improvements (iii) Administration and (iv) Public Safety vehicles and facilities and equipment; and (i) for the City of Whitesburg, Georgia: (i) City Hall, (ii) Police Department, (iii) Recreation, (iv) Water, (v) Roads, Streets, Bridges, and Sidewalks, and (vi) Senior Center?
